GCSE Summary

GCSE results showed a clear upward trend across all key measures with a 1% rise in the number of students gaining English and Maths grade C/4+ or above. The number of students gaining a 4+ in English increased by an impressive 18% with almost three quarters of students gaining a standard pass, 3% above the National Average figure.

A Level Summary

A level results were consistent this year with the overall pass rate rising and almost a quarter achieving A*/A grades. Once again, BTEC performed very well at Level 3 with an average grade of Distinction+ across all subjects. As a result, a record number of students were successful in their applications to university.
